Composer's Notes

A Prayer Before Nightfall is intended to evoke the style of folk songs. When working on this piece, I imagined a gathering of a large group of people, friends and family. I imagined them all raising their voices in a kind of blessing of their fellowship. I could almost hear the words they were singing and often took my inspiration for the melodic and rhythmic elements from these ghostly voices.

The piece should be played legato with very few breaks. Moving lines should be heard at all times, and careful consideration should be given to the balance when solo lines are being presented. Students should be encouraged to really LISTEN to their sounds and produce a dark, warm tone. Students should also be encouraged to use vibrato whenever appropriate.

During this time, he also studied composition with Dr. Tom O'Connor.
